Addition and Subtraction Situations

	Result Unknown	Change Unknown	Start Unknown
Add to	$3 + 1 = \square$	$2 + \square = 5$	$\square + 4 = 5$
Take from	$5 - 1 = \square$	$4 - \square = 2$	$\square - 3 = 2$

	Whole Unknown	Both Parts Unknown	Part Unknown
Part/ Part/ Whole	$1 + \square = 4$	$\square + \square = 5$	$2 + \square = 5$

	Difference Unknown	Bigger Unknown	Smaller Unknown
Compare	$5 - 2 = \square$	$\square - 1 = 6$	$5 - \square = 3$
