Student Device Acceptance Letter

Egg Harbor Township School District

The Egg Harbor Township School District is providing devices for use at home and in school for all students in grades 6-12. The student will maintain the same device throughout their Egg Harbor Township middle school and or high school careers.

Examples:

- a student entering 6th grade will receive and maintain the same device through 8th grade.
- a student entering 9th grade will receive and maintain the same device through 12th grade.

Upon receipt of this letter we ask that you review the district's acceptable use policy with your child. The policy can be found on the district's website at <u>www.eht.k12.nj.us</u>, then under the Board of Education and Board Policies sections. <u>Policy 2361: Acceptable Use of Computer Network, Computers and Resources</u>

It is expected that the device is only used for educational purposes to complete the necessary work, research or assessments as assigned by instructional staff. In addition, the only individual that uses the device should be the student for which it was assigned. Furthermore, the student should also adhere to other best practices such as the proper use of the internet, as well as proper care, from carrying and transporting the device. Lastly, the district prohibits the use of food and drink while using the device.

Damage and or non-working devices must be reported and returned to your child's school immediately. A loaner device may be provided until your child's assigned device is repaired. All devices must stay in its original district provided case and your child must <u>not</u> mark the case or device with markers, paint, stickers, etc.

Students will be expected to ensure the device is charged and bring it to school as per teacher direction for use in class and online assessments.

If the student device is stolen, the Egg Harbor Township School District requires that the parent/guardian file a police report. The student is responsible for the replacement cost of a new device, if stolen or lost. Payment for any lost or stolen device must be made in the amount of \$280.00 via cash or check. Checks must be made payable to Egg Harbor Township Board of Education (or EHTBOE). Payment must be made in order to receive a replacement device.
