LITERACY BLOCK

Students are learning all about the workshop-learning model and meeting the SUPERKIDS! They are learning to work independently and in small groups to build reading and writing stamina!







SKILLS FOCUS:

- The first few weeks students will be in a review unit to familiarize themselves with the SuperKids and to review reading, writing and phonics skills.
- Students will also be given readiness assessments to make sure their needs are met.

AT HOME CONNECTION:

Questions to ask your child about his/her reading:

- What has happened so far in the story? Can you tell me using sequence words? (first, then, next, after, finally, etc.)
- Who are the main characters? What can you tell me about them?
- How do you think the story will end?
- When you read, what pictures did you see in your head?
- What do you do when you come across a word you can't read?

What do you do when you come to a tricky word?	Look at the pictures. 	Is your mouth ready? 
Start again. 	Does that make sense? 	Say the word slowly. m-o-m d-o-g
Skip it, read on,  then go back.	Look for chunks. an in ing sh ack	Where have I seen that before?
